

Clue #1: LOVE My Scraps Mystery Quilt

Fabric Needed

Quilt Size	Background Fabric See note in cutting directions below	Biding Fabric	Backing Fabric	Scraps/Strips See note in cutting directions below
A 46"x 62"	2 yards	1/2 yard	2 yd + 7" wide pieced strip or 4 yd	Assorted Scraps 2 yds total
B 62"x 77"	3 1/2 yards	5/8 yard	2 1/2 yd + 24" wide pieced strip or 5 yd	Assorted Scraps 3 yds total
C 77"x 93"	5 1/2 yards	3/4 yard	5 1/2 yd	Assorted Scraps 4 yds total

This quilt is a somewhat modern style and a great way to use your scraps! Once you discover how much you like it, you may decide to make it larger by simply making more blocks. More background, binding and backing will be needed in this case.

Other Supplies Needed

- Thread to coordinate with background fabric
- General Quilting supplies scissors, seam ripper, rotary cutter, mat
- Fun-Dation paper piecing paper 4 sheets for A, 6 sheets for B, 10 sheets for C
- Glue stick
- Ball point pen and small ruler
- Add-A-Quarter or Add-an-Eighth ruler with 3"x 6" piece of cardboard
- Frixion Pen or other fabric marking pen
- Walking foot and 1/4" foot for sewing machine
- 6"x 24" rotary cutting ruler
- 12 1/2" square rotary cutting ruler

Sorting and Cutting

- Begin by sorting your scraps and strips by color (make a pile of reds, a pile of yellows, a pile of oranges, a pile of greens, a pile of blues, etc.) choose two or three of the largest piles and leave the rest at home.
- You will need assorted strips from 1" - 5" wide and 2 1/2" to 12 1/2" long. Press your strips.
- Choose a white, natural, cream or tan background fabric that will go with your assorted strips. If the majority of your strips are light in color, you may choose to use a dark or black background.
- From your background strips, cut:
 - Quilt A: Cut 20 strips 3 1/4", sub cut into 24 rectangles 18" long and 24 rectangles 12 1/2" long
 - Quilt B: Cut 34 strips 3 1/4", sub cut into 40 rectangles 18" long and 40 rectangles 12 1/2" long
 - Quilt C: Cut 50 strips 3 1/4", sub cut into 60 rectangles 18" long and 60 rectangles 12 1/2" long
