

Color Your Own Bulletin Board

Supplies:

- Three fat quarters
- Two Empty Fabric Bolt Boards
- Wide shipping tape, inexpensive stuff is great!
- Tacky Glue
- Stapler
- Fabric Markers

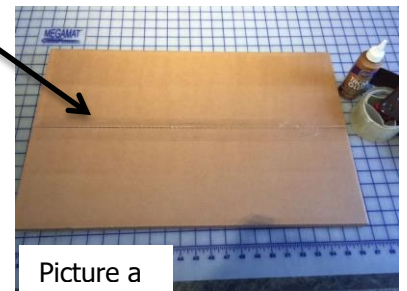


Constructing the Bulletin Board

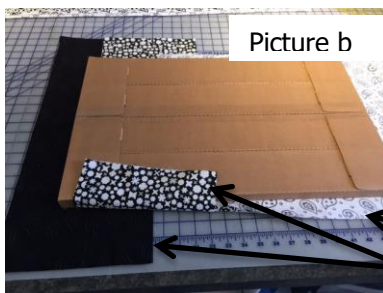
Glue two empty fabric bolt boards together on one long side with tacky glue. Tape front and back along this seam, see picture a.

Glue and Tape Here

Fold the two fat quarters, that go on the left side of the board, in half to make 22"x 9" rectangles. Fold with right sides out and press.

Lay folded fat quarters as shown in picture b with folded edges toward center of board. Lay unfolded fat quarter as shown in picture b with right side down.

Center glued together boards on fat quarters. Glue around the edge of the fabric that extends beyond the boards. See picture c. Bring fabric edges to back of board and staple in place. Begin with the single layer fat quarter on the right and end with the last fat quarter on the left. Do one fabric piece at a time. Try not to overlap the staples.

Turn your board over and color as desired.

Press colored fabric lightly with a hot iron to set the colors. Avoid over-pressing on the taped area (center seam) of boards so tape does not peel off.

Hang on wall with 3-M™ Velcro Strips or method of your choice.
