

# four square hearts quilt

## SUPPLIES:

- ♥ Four background squares cut 4 3/4"
- ♥ Two strips sashing 1" x 40"
- ♥ Twenty-Two 2" squares assorted colors
- ♥ Four squares 4 1/2" for hearts with fusible web on back
- ♥ One 12 1/2" square of backing and fusible batting
- ♥ One 11" x 4" rectangle for hanging sleeve
- ♥ Hearts and More® small template set, template B



## directions:

- ♥ Cut the sashing strips two @ 1"x 4 3/4", three @ 1"x 9 1/2" and two @ 1"x 10 1/2". **12" x 12"**
- ♥ Sew sashing to background squares as shown in picture above.
- ♥ Sew ten 2" squares together to make top border and another ten to make bottom border. Sew to top and bottom of center section.
- ♥ Sew twelve 2" squares together to make side borders. Sew to sides of quilt.
- ♥ Fold the heart fabric in half and use the Hearts and More® template B, 2 1/2" curved heart side, 90° and lowercase "L" marking on the fold to cut out all four hearts. (Or make template from heart shape below, trace around and cut out of heart fabrics.)
- ♥ Iron hearts to quilt top, placing as desired.
- ♥ Attach fusible batting to back of quilt top. Trim to quilt top size.
- ♥ Fold hanging sleeve rectangle lengthwise with right sides together, stitch 1/4" seam on both short sides. Turn right side out, poking out corners. Press, keeping raw edges even.
- ♥ Center hanging sleeve at top of quilt right side, making raw edges even. Pin in place. Stay stitch 1/8" around outside edge of quilt top, attaching hanging sleeve.
- ♥ Place back of quilt right sides together with quilt top. Stitch 1/4" seam around outside edge, leaving a 4" section on one side for turning.
- ♥ Trim corners and batting in seam allowance. Turn right side out, press raw edges of opening 1/4" to inside. Press all the way around the quilt, pressing turning sleeve to back.
- ♥ Topstitch 1/8" from outside edge around quilt. Stitch in the "ditch" around the inner border.
- ♥ Use decorative stitches to applique raw edges of hearts, this will quilt the quilt.
- ♥ Hand stitch the bottom edge of the hanging sleeve to the back of the quilt.
