### Iron Tote & Travel

#### **Supplies needed:**

- 35 charm (5") squares
- Oprional: 24 squares @ 3½" (if you do not wish to use the twister ruler)
- Lil' Twister Tool/Ruler (the one for 5" squares)
- ½ yard of fabric that coordinates with charm squares
- 1 1/4 yard of fabric for ironing surface (muslin)
- 50" or 1 2/3 yard of 1/8" or 1/4" diameter cording
- 1 ½ yards of 22" wide batting used in hot pads
- 1/2 yard (13"x 19") of 100% cotton batting
- Cotton thread to coordinate with fabrics chosen
- 9" of hook and loop tape (Velcro)
- 22" <u>separating</u> zipper
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Zipper foot, ¼" foot and walking foot for sewing machine
- Size 100 Jeans Needles
- 505 Quilt Basting Spray
- Wonder Tape ¼" wide

# The fabric requirements are generous, to allow for uneven cuts, shrinkage and minor mistakes – and because most quilter's would rather have too much fabric than not enough.
