Winter Wonderland Mini Quilt

Supplies Needed:

- Cotton thread to coordinate with fabrics
- White thread for snowflake applique
- 6 sheets Fun-Dation piecing paper
- black ball-point pen or scanner/printer
- rotary cutter, mat and 6" square ruler
- "Add and Eighth" ruler & cardboard insert
- assorted scraps of fabric for piecing the blocks and border corner blocks
- 3"x 16" white fabric and 3"x 6" blue for snowflakes
- Fat quarter of light blue fabric for backing
- 1/2 yard of fabric for backing and border
- Misty Fuse and parchment paper or paper backed fusible webbing - enough to back white and blue strips for snowflakes
- 17" square of cotton batting
- 1/8 yard fabric for binding
- fabric glue stick, 505 adhesive spray

The fabric requirements are generous, to allow for uneven cuts, shrinkage and minor mistakes – and because most quilter's would rather have too much fabric than not enough. Every effort has been made to be sure the instructions are accurate, however, we cannot be held responsible for errors that may have occurred.
